Dear Parents,

It is hard to believe that we are into the final quarter of the school year. Spring is here and we will be finishing up this school year soon. We are currently taking the Stanford Achievement Test. Many of our students will show tremendous growth educationally; we have covered a lot of material.

Some students, however, have experienced difficulties throughout the year. Many of these students could use some extra instruction to help them get ready for next year. We have discussed at length what we can do to help them. Summer school seems a logical solution. So, we are again offering a 7th and 8th grade summer session at WCCS. Our major curricular emphasis will be in the Math and Language Arts area. We would like to enroll students who:

1. ...struggle in Math and/or English
2. ...would like to get ahead in their Math group or English class, that is, enrichment
3. ...would better retain this year's learning by reducing the time with no instruction – extending the instruction time and shortening the summer slump time.
4. ...would like to use summer school as a way to be introduced to Jr. High. It helps with the transition and gives confidence as they begin seventh grade.
