

A Note From The Principals Desk

Dear Parents:

I hope that you are having an enjoyable summer with your families. It seems hard to believe that school will begin again on September 6th. This will be a half-day with dismissal at 12 noon. Day Care will be available.

We will have one class assignment day in the Sanctuary on August 25th from 9:00am – 12 noon and 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. Please come to the time that best fits your schedule. Enclosed are the materials that you will need to bring along so that your child will be ready on the first day of school. We will have other information at that time on various programs that are available to your child. It is a good time to find out about our vocal, instrumental and dance programs. If you want to volunteer at school during the year, we encourage you to sign up for PTF (Parent Teacher Fellowship) or with your child's teacher at Back to School Night. We appreciate all those who donate their time.

Our school uniform supplier is Red Dot Uniforms in El Monte. They have a listing of our approved selections. Uniforms will be available at Red Dot Uniforms throughout the year. WCCS uniform t-shirts will be on sale at Class Assignment Day. You can return the enclosed order blank with your check to the school office. If you order them by August 5th, our 8th grade parents will have them ready for you to pick up at Class Assignment Day. Again, this year each grade will be required to have a class color t-shirt. The color is listed on the student supply list. These will be worn on field trip days. Please note Red Dot uniform sweatshirts and jackets are required this year. To make this transition year manageable you may wear solid school color sweatshirts or jackets.


You may purchase the New International Version (NIV) of the Bible for your second through eighth grade student at Class Assignment Day. This is the version used in our Bible Curriculum. PE clothes for 5th -8th grade students can also be purchased then.

It is not too late to earn credit towards tuition if you use the enclosed form to refer a new student who is not from our school family and who is accepted and enrolls in WCCS. If you refer a new student to the Preschool – 6th grade you can earn a \$225 credit, or if you refer a 7th or 8th grader you can earn a \$300 credit. Credit will be made to your final tuition payment. The referred child must attend for a month in order to receive credit. *Remember, there is no limit to how many credits you can earn.*

I know the sacrifice financially you are making on behalf of your child. You are making an investment for their future and for future generations. I appreciate your support and am blessed to have such wonderful families on our campus!
