Worship Dance Classes

(Mrs. Garcia has been teaching dance at WCCS for the past 14 years. She is also the Worship Dance Director for Bethany Church and Percussionist for the Christian Rock band Saltwater.

-My heart's desire is that your student would come to know who God has created them to be. That they would experience the incredible love of their heavenly father, and know what it means to worship freely in spirit and truth.

When: Classes take place once a week and will start the second week of school, through June 2011.

Mondays ~3:00-4:00pm.

Where: Students change clothes and meet me at the 400 building bathrooms. From there I walk them over to our dance room called "The Refuge." It is located at the corner of the North parking lot.

What do we learn: Students will be learning Contemporary Dance Techniques. All classes are taught in a professional manner. Students will learn terminology, basic techniques, and more advanced techniques as they progress. They will also be trained in Pilates work out movements, as well as stretches to strengthen their bodies while also creating more flexibility. Students will listen to and discuss Christian Music, while learning to put movement and emotion to words and song. Students will not only learn choreography, but will also be trained in how to create their own movements.

How much are classes: Classes are \$55.00 per month. Plus a onetime supply fee of \$35 and a onetime fee for the dance costume.

What do we wear: Students will have one costume that they will wear for all performances. During regular classes they may wear comfortable stretchy clothes, like a dance leotard and dance pants, or sweatpants and a t-shirt and slip on leather dance shoes.

When will we dance: Students will dance in the Prelude to a school Musical, in two School Chapels, and an end of the year church performance.
