A book report form will be sent home when your book is approved. The report will be graded for Neatness, Complete Sentences, Important Facts, Capitalization/Punctuation and your Creativity in designing the postage stamp. This will be a language grade and you will receive reading credit.

POSTAGE STAMP:

Design a postage stamp in honor of this important person. Design one that has a likeness of the person, or a picture of their accomplishments.

For Example:

Wilbur and Orville Wright with a picture of a plane.
